*How many players do you need for a
tournament?*

ONLY 40 players are required to host an event at Wolf Hollow. Many courses require a guarantee of 100 or more players in order to have an outing.

*How much money can we expect to raise in an
event?*

Obviously it depends on the number of players, the number of donations and the entry fee. A reasonable amount of money can be raised with an event of 40-80 players. Typically an event with 40-60 players could expect to raise \$3,000-\$5,000 and an event with 60-80 players could expect to raise \$4,000-\$7,000. The more involvement on the part of the committee, the more money that will be raised for the charity or group.

I don't have a big committee to help. Can I still have a tournament?

Absolutely, that is where Wolf Hollow shines. You solicit players and however many (or few) donors and sponsors you can; register them the day of the event and we can do everything else.

Do we have to buy food and beverages through Wolf Hollow?

No, we allow outside groups to bring in food and donated beverage for a nominal fee.

How much will green fees cost for an event?

Green fees are dependent on the time of day and the day of the week requested. Wolf Hollow provides one of the greatest golf values throughout the entire St. Louis metropolitan area. Here's what Wolf Hollow does:

1. Attend your committee meetings to assist in outing setup;
2. Make hole assignments;
3. Prepare rules sheets, scorecards and cart tags;
4. Setup carts prior to event with participants names, starting hole assignments, scorecards, rule sheets and "Goodie Bags" (if provided);
5. Place range balls on range;
6. Ice down beverages, place on course and restock as needed;
7. Place hole sponsor signs on course and pickup following completion of event;

8. Place proximity markers on course (closest-to-pin, long drive, etc.) and pick up following completion of play;
9. Greet players as they arrive; bring their bag from their car to their golf cart and direct them to registration, meals or other activities;
10. Announce rules prior to the tournament;
11. Escort players to their starting holes;
12. Prepare, serve and clean up after any meals provided by Wolf Hollow;
13. Collect scorecards, post scores, breakdown flights, calculate skins, determine winners and announce results;
14. Thank you and all of your committee for allowing us to host your event.

Here's what you do:

1. Meet with Wolf Hollow staff to outline event details;
2. Solicit players, sponsors and donors (giveaway items, auction items, hole sponsors, etc.)

3. Provide Wolf Hollow with a list of players;
4. Register players as they arrive (collect payment either before they arrive or at registration);
- 5. Play in the event, don't worry about a thing and enjoy the day;*
6. Thank participants following the round;
7. Donate the net proceeds to your charity or group;
8. Accept the praise and gratitude for a job well done.
